



## District Chess Tournament for Elementary, Jr. High, and High School

Saturday February 29, 2020 8:30 am - 1:00 pm approximately

Please park on east side of building.

- Arrive at 8:30 am, instructions at 8:45 am.
- 5 or 6 rounds—all students get to play all rounds.
- K-6 students get to play others within their own grade.  
Jr. High students will be grouped together into one section.  
High School students will be grouped together into one section.  
9<sup>th</sup> grade will join either Jr. High or High School based on numbers.
- Rounds are up to 50 minutes each (i.e. approximately 25 minutes per player). Grades 7-12 may be allowed up to 60 minutes each.
- Plan on students finishing last round between 12:30 pm and 2:00 pm.
- Trophies will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> -7<sup>th</sup> place per section (plus several “outstanding” trophies), and for top 3 elementary schools, top 2 junior highs, and the top high school. All other players will receive a medal.
- Tie breaks will be decided by the computer.
