Class Request Information for the 2018-2019 School Year

In order for a request to be accepted, it must be completed according to the guidelines, have a secretary's signature approving the form, and must be received by a member of our office staff during the request window (**May 14-25**). Forms will not be sent home. I will consider the gathered information along with other academic and school information as I work to create classes that are balanced according to range of student ability, behaviors, gender, and the number of students.
